

RESOLUTION
of the Tenth International Conference
within the framework of the Cultural Project "Delphic Orel - 2015"
(Orel region, 4 May 2015)

From 1st to 6th of May 2015 in the Orel region the Cultural Project "Delphic Orel - 2015" is being held. Within the framework of the Project the anniversary Tenth Youth Delphic Games of the CIS Member States and the Fourteenth Youth Delphic Games of Russia are organized; they are dedicated to the 70th anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945 and the Year of literature in the Russian Federation. 1943 artists at the age from 10 to 25 years old from 15 countries, including 9 countries of the Commonwealth, and 71 constitutional entities of the Russian Federation, as well as more than 130 prominent jury members and guests participate in the Games.

The Tenth International Conference was held as part of the Project. The Conference was attended by leaders and representatives of the International Delphic Committee, UNESCO, federal and regional authorities of the Russian Federation, National Delphic organizations of the number of countries, the Government of the Orel region, institutions of higher education. The conference participants discussed the issues in three focus areas:

- Victory in the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945 as an important factor of civil-patriotic upbringing;
- Literature in the life of the younger generation;
- Delphic Games as an effective tool for finding and supporting young talents in the field of arts and culture.

Noting that over the past 16 years the Delphic Games became a major cultural forum, an effective tool of search and support for talented young people, an important factor in the preservation of cultural heritage, promotion of intercultural dialogue and development of the world culture, the participants find it necessary to:

1. Note that thanks to many years of support and direction of greetings to the Delphic Games of the President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin, assistance of the Presidential Executive Office of the Russian Federation, the Government of the Russian Federation, the Council of Federation and the State Duma of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, the Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoys of the Russian Federation to the Federal Districts, the Executive Committee of the Commonwealth of Independent States, the Inter-Parliamentary Assembly of the CIS Member States, the Interstate Fund for Humanitarian Cooperation of the CIS Member States, higher officials of the constitutional entities of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, the Federation of Independent Trade Unions of Russia, the Federal Agency for the Commonwealth of Independent States, Compatriots Living Abroad and International Humanitarian Cooperation, the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs, the State Russian House of Folk Art, attention to the Delphic Games of UNESCO, the Council of Europe, the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, the European Commission, cooperation with a wide range of partners, the Delphic Games at the turn of the 21st century have become a unique innovative

mechanism for major social and educational events in the field of culture, education and youth policies that promote interethnic dialogue and dissemination of universal values;

2. Thank the International Delphic Committee, the National Delphic organization and representations of the International Delphic Committee in countries, that created a modern mechanism for national, regional and municipal cultural, youth and educational activities implemented on the basis of recognition of its essential consolidating mission, promoting international integration;
3. Underline high importance of the Cultural Project "Delphic Orel - 2015" in realization of national and international plans of the events dedicated to the 70th anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic War of 1941 - 1945;
4. Recommend to the International Delphic Committee to take additional measures to promote at all levels experience of organization of the Delphic events for popularization the Delphic Games' achievements at international, national, regional and local levels;
5. Offer to concerned representatives of countries to intensify efforts in submitting applications from the cities (countries) to participate in the bid to host the Third World Delphic Games in 2016;
6. Welcome the initiative of the National Delphic Council of Russia on organizing and holding the First Paradelphic Games;
7. Note the importance of the expert groups' work under the National Delphic Council of Russia on the relevant areas of scientific and practical activities in the social and cultural sphere. With the active involvement of these expert groups several projects were developed such as the campaign "Be in Art", the researches "The cultural basket of a young man in the Russian Federation" and "The impact assessment of cultural resources for social and economic development of territories";
8. Ask the National Delphic Council of Russia in the cooperation with concerned federal executive authorities of the Russian Federation to study the possibility of additional events for attracting children and young people to culture and practicing different kinds of creative work in educational process;
9. Emphasize the concerned position of the African Delphic Committee in the development of multilateral cultural cooperation;
10. Taking into account the priorities of the Year of literature in the Russian Federation, to offer to the International Delphic Committee the consideration of nominations for the active development in the field of literature;
11. Support the proposal of the official representative of the National Delphic Council of Russia in the Northwest Federal District Elena Maltseva (St. Petersburg) on the formation of chronicles of the Delphic Games and to advise the International Delphic Committee to organize the work in this focus area with the coordinating role as the initiator.
